### New Student Enrollment

New to Gresham High School? Students who did NOT attend a middle school in the Gresham-Barlow School District or who have recently moved and/or transferred into the Gresham High School attendance area need to schedule an appointment for enrollment. Please contact the counseling office at 503-674-5508 beginning August 7th to make an appointment. ### Freshman/New Student Orientation

At Gresham High School, the first day of school, Tuesday, September 5, 2017, has been set aside for Freshmen. A full school day's worth of student orientation activities has been planned, including ice-breakers, assemblies, building tours, and an opportunity to walk through a condensed version of their class schedules to meet their new teachers. Please have your child report to the MAIN GYM at the beginning of the day. Because this is a school day, bus transportation and lunch services will be provided on a normal basis. Students who are not Freshmen but are new to GHS will also have an opportunity to tour the facility. Check with the office the week before school starts for the time.

### Mail-In Registration

We will be mailing the registration packet later this month which will include the student verification form, the 2017-18 fees list and instructions for paying as well as a letter from Principal Michael Schaefer.

To complete the registration process for the 2017-2018 school year, the following items must be **returned by mail** to the GHS Student Fees Office by September 8, 2017.

- **Student Verification Form.** Please be sure to make any necessary changes as this will allow us to make sure that we have the most up to date and accurate information on file for your student. **This form needs to be turned in with a signature whether you make changes or not.**
- Please pay all school fees online at our webstore. To access this please go to our website at <http://ghs.gresham.k12.or.us> then choose Pay Fees Online. If unable to pay online then please return your Billing Statement/invoice along with a check or money order made out to "GHS".
- We are unable to take credit card payments in the school. You can only use a credit card when paying online.

Beginning August 29<sup>th</sup> student schedules will be available for viewing through the ParentVUE & StudentVUE accounts. For incoming freshmen your accounts from Clear Creek & Dexter McCarty are still your accounts for high school. Please read below to learn how you can access counselors for schedule questions.

Current GHS Students & Parents are reminded of the following regarding schedule change requests:

- Current students whose schedule have a "hole" or have a "see counselor" notation will be able to see a counselor on Wednesday, September 6<sup>th</sup> and Thursday, September 7<sup>th</sup>. Students should come to the counseling office during the period that has the issue. Counselors are not available to take calls in August regarding schedule changes – please email any requests that you have directly to them. They will check their email as they are able.
- Schedule changes will be made only to meet specific academic needs and/or to fulfill graduation requirements.
- Some courses may not be available due to enrollment limitations and/or conflicts with other courses.

## PARENTVUE

ParentVue offers parents and guardians the ability to check their student's attendance, assignments, grades and demographic information online. It is a very convenient method for keeping track of your student's academic performance. Those who accessed this service last year should still have an active account. Incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders that attended school in our district last year should also still have the same account. If you have not used this service in the past we encourage you to set up an account. To get an account just call the Main office to get your activation information. If you have an account already, but forgot the password, simply go to the login screen of Parentvue and click the *forgot password* link and the program will email you your login password.

## P.E. Uniforms

The PE uniform for GHS is a gray T-shirt and royal blue shorts. PE uniforms may be purchased from Gresham High School per availability for \$20.00 or provided at families expense. Students providing their own uniform must have a solid gray T-shirt and solid royal blue shorts with minimal brand logos on them.

## Supply Lists

Supply lists are not issued for the high school age student. In general, students will need a folder/binder, notebook paper and a writing utensil. Teachers will let students know if they need a specific supply item for their class. Office Depot donates 5% of your purchase back to Gresham High School. Use ID #70083769 when making purchases.

## School Pictures

*School Pictures to Occur September 5th (Frosh Only) & 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> (all other students).*

School pictures and ID card pictures for Freshman will be taken during the Frosh Orientation Day on Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>. All 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students will have their pictures taken on Thursday, Sept. 7<sup>th</sup> & Friday, Sept. 8<sup>th</sup>. Student's pictures will be taken during their English class. All students (including seniors) are required to have an identification photo taken. The purchase of a photography package from Lifetouch Company is an individual family decision. Cost information will be included in the verification form mailing. Lifetouch has a website where you can order your school pictures online. CAL and ACE students will be allowed to get their pictures taken during their time here at GHS.

## Senior Yearbook Pictures

You have made it through the first three years and now you are moving into your final and most important year of high school. It is time for senior pictures. There are a few guidelines when selecting your picture to represent you in the yearbook. Remember, a yearbook is around forever. Please make sure you reserve your copy of the yearbook to see your submission. If you do not submit an alternate photo for the yearbook, the photo taken by Lifetouch for the Student ID card will be used in the yearbook.

**Submission Guidelines: Deadline - December 19, 2017.**

- Format: **Digital Submissions Only**
- Cropping: Photos will be cropped for you, only head and shoulders will be visible in the Yearbook
- Photos can be submitted in color or black and white
- Hats/hoods in pictures will not be accepted
- Please no hands covering any part of the face
- Selfies will not be accepted
- Avoid submitting a tight cropped photo of face
- Yearbook Photographers will be available to take senior pictures for all students who need, for free.
- Cell Phone Cameras: with the high quality nature of current cell phone cameras, pictures may be taken with one if needed.
- All submissions will be confirmed via email.

**Bus Information**

Bus routes for the Gresham-Barlow School District are published in the Gresham Outlook. Each year the Outlook produces a Back to School insert in one of the August editions. Please use this insert to find your bus routes for Gresham High School. The school will have copies of the insert available for pickup after it has been published in the paper.

**Student Lockers**

Freshmen are assigned lockers. The locker assignment and combination are printed on the student schedules that will be sent in your mail-in registration packet. Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors who are interested in using a locker will need to come to the main office to complete a request form for a locker. Sign ups will occur on a "first come, first served" basis. Students should be aware that they may be assigned a locker partner as we do not have enough lockers for each student to have their own locker.

**Parking Information**

*On-campus parking permits will be issued to Jrs and Srs.* Campus parking spaces will be available to students with registered vehicles and parking permits on a first come, first served basis.

To purchase a parking permit, students will need to pay the \$25.00 fee on our website and download the application form. Students will need to turn in the completed application and a receipt of payment to receive a pass. Passes are issued on a first come, first served basis from the security office. For those students who do not receive a campus parking permit, there are some important points to consider:

- Student parking West of N. Main on the streets between NW Division and NW Burnside is **not** permitted. This area is for city-issued parking permit vehicles only. These permits are for area residents only. Repeated student use of guest permits from legitimate residents must be limited to short-term use and will be valid only in front of the resident's address.
- Vehicles parked in violation of any parking ordinance or statute may receive a citation and possibly be impounded without notice.
- The east (school) side of N. Main is not open for parking from NE Division to the tennis courts. Posted signs mark this area as either Loading Zone-Driver Must Remain at Wheel, or Emergency Vehicle Parking Only.
- The west side of N. Main is open for parking as posted signs allow.

If you have questions regarding on-campus parking, please contact the Security Office.

**Student Body Cards**

*An ASB Sticker saves money on school events!*

Students can purchase an ASB Sticker for their Student ID Card for \$20.00. This sticker will allow a GHS student free entrance to all HOME athletic events as well as reduce the price of tickets to school dances. Please look for the option to purchase this item on your fee statement when your registration packet arrives.

**Student Dress**

*Students need to use good judgment*

Use of good judgment in dress and grooming is the primary responsibility of the student and his/her parents or guardians. Please note that students with immodest attire which is disruptive to our learning environment may be asked to modify their clothing. Also note that students are not permitted to wear hats or other head coverings, including hoods, bandanas, etc. during school hours. Students will be given more information on this policy when school starts.

**Attendance Information**

*Procedures for absences and tardiness.*

**ALL ABSENCES MUST BE EXCUSED WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER THE STUDENT'S RETURN TO SCHOOL.**

Upon return the student may bring a written note from a parent/guardian to the attendance office. A doctor or dental excuse may serve in lieu of a parent/guardian note. *A phone call from the parent/guardian is also acceptable for excusing an absence. The phone number is 503-674-5519.* Absences can be cleared by the attendance office before school, during lunch, and after school.

**ADMITTANCE FOR TARDINESS**

Students who arrive to school after having been absent for part of the day must report directly to the attendance window before reporting to class. Otherwise, as a general rule, students who are tardy to class should proceed directly to class. A student who misses the first 10 minutes or more of a class will be marked with an "Unexcused Absence" for the class. For tardiness to class of less than 10 minutes, a student will be marked as "Tardy". In either case, a teacher may assign the student a consequence in accordance with the teacher's individual tardy policy. In situations where a tardy is excused (e.g. a teacher-to-teacher pass, or note from parent) it is ultimately the responsibility of the student to ensure that his or her attendance is marked or updated accurately. To ensure accuracy in such cases, the student is strongly encouraged to clear the matter directly with the main office attendance window before reporting to class.

**Cell Phones**

Students may possess cell phones at school but they MAY NOT be used during class time. Students who use a cell phone, or other electronic communication device, for any reason (making or accepting calls, text messaging, photo display, etc.) during instructional time will be considered insubordinate. The phone or electronic device will be confiscated by school personnel and disciplinary action may be taken as needed. Gresham High School is not responsible for lost or stolen cell phones or electronic devices.

**GBSD Family Athletic Pass**

Thank you for purchasing a Gresham Barlow School District Family Athletic Pass for the 2017-18 school year. The pass is good at all **Regular Season**, HOME athletic events, at **both** Gresham and Barlow High Schools, with the exception of fundraising events, Conference and Non-Conference Play-Off Events, and any OSAA Play-In or Play-Off event. Fundraising events where the pass will **NOT** be honored include: Jamborees, Tournaments, Endowment Games and Exhibition Games.

Your pass will work at Home Football, Volleyball, Boys and Girls Basketball and Wrestling at Both Gresham and Barlow. (See exceptions above). Regular Admission is \$6 per adult and \$4 per student. So a GBSD Family Pass = Big Savings!!

**How the Pass Works:**

All immediate family members listed on the pass need not arrive at the same time. Each gate will have an updated list of pass holders, and the family members for each pass. **Please remember to include your student athlete on the list.** **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Lists are shared with Barlow only once a week – so if you purchased a pass during the week you plan to attend a game at Barlow – you might want to bring it with you.

Note: If you purchase your Pass online – please remember to include all your family members' names. Passes purchased on the same day of competition may not be valid unless purchased at the athletic gate. **Pass Lists will NOT be updated the same day of a competition by the Athletic Office.**

**NO ATHLETIC PASSES WILL BE SOLD ONLINE OR AT THE ATHLETIC OFFICE ON GAME DAYS.** Day of game purchases are always available at the entry gate.
